- City of Naples Beaches remain CLOSED through April 30th. Walking, sitting, swimming, congregating and sunset watching are prohibited.
- Download the Naples Fire Department's App to get current and upto-date information on the coronavirus sourced directly from the CDC. Search "Naples Fire FL" in the app store or google play to download the app.
- Collier Commissioners have not yet issued a "shelter-in-place" for Naples, but strongly encourages maintaining social distancing and practicing safe hygiene through April 30th. The cases in Collier County have increased to 119 cases as of March 30th. We will continue to monitor for new developments. Stay smart!



NCH HEALTHCARE SYSTEM: DONATIONS NEEDED



In this challenging time for our community, our hospitals need your help. They are requesting donations for any protective gear, including:

- Masks (any kind)
- Gowns/ Suits (Tyvek or any suits)
- Gloves
- Booties
- Hoods
- Hand sanitizers

There has been some questions as to how to safely make a hand-sewn mask. The following tips should be observed when making hand-sewn masks:

- 1. Mask fabric should be pre-washed in hot water and dried to pre-shrink the fabric to provide better protection.
- 2. Two fabric layers are better than one layer.
- 3. Elastic ear loops are preferred.
- 4. Please freshly launder after sewing is completed.
- 5. Place one mask each in a ziplock bag for distribution. Please deliver supplies Monday to Friday 8 a.m. 5 p.m. to NCH Central Campus (2157 Pine Ridge Rd, Naples, FL 34109). The security guard will receive the items.
